

POLICY

It is the policy of The Wellington County Board of Education to make student accident insurance available in its schools.

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Administrative Detail

1. It is the responsibility of the appropriate Superintendent to administer this policy.
2. In accordance with the Education Act, coverage of students by an external carrier is voluntary and the premium cost for such coverage is to be paid by parents.
3. Any accidents requiring major medical attention must be reported, through the Superintendent of Finance, to the Ontario School Boards' Insurance Exchange on its Incident form.

NOTE: The Ontario School Boards' Insurance Exchange uses the word "incident" to refer to an accident.

POLICY

It is the policy of The Wellington County Board of Education to provide health support services in accordance with Ministry of Education guidelines.

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Administrative Detail

1. It is the responsibility of the appropriate Superintendent to monitor this policy.
2. It is the responsibility of the Principal to administer the policy.
3. The Principal may consult with the Wellington-Dufferin-Guelph Health Unit when establishing in-school procedures.
4. This policy shall be administered in accordance with the Health Support Services Manual 5305-A and with the following forms and resources:
  1. Consent for Administration of Oral Medication - 5305-1
  2. Administration of Oral Medication Log - 5305-2
  3. School Student Admission/Information Form 5018-1
  4. First-Aid Procedures 5305-3
  5. List of First-Aid Materials - 5305-4
  6. Home Care Program/School Health Support Services -5305-5
  7. Parental Consent to Administer Medication in a Life-Threatening Situation - 5305-6
